



Vascular Access Tips

What to enter for “Date Access Type Changed”

For “Date Access Type Changed” CWeb will not allow a date prior to patient’s arrival at your facility, so if the patient's current access type existed prior to his/her admission to your facility, you should enter the date patient was admitted to your facility**.

** This also applies to AV Fistula Usable Date and AV Fistula Creation Date.

You Must Enter “Date Access Type Changed” Every Month

Once the patient’s Access Type, State of Access, and Measurements have been entered into CROWNWeb this info will carry-over from month-to-month (i.e. the data entered in January will be pre-populated into February.) However, “Date Access Type Changed” WILL NOT carry-over from month-to-month; you MUST go into CROWNWeb monthly and enter the date the access type changed.

NOTE: If you forget to enter the “Date Access Type Changed” for any given month – ALL previously entered vascular access data will be lost.
